### DARDI MUNWURRO IS A CHILD SAFE ORGANISATION

### RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

As a participant in the Dardi Munwurro program you have the right to:

- Respect
- A culturally appropriate service
- A safe and high quality service
- Good communication
- Assistance if you are unhappy with our service, and to have a support person assist you
- Be involved in decision making and ask questions about how we support you
- Make a complaint

As a participant, you have the responsibility to:

- Provide us with correct and up-to-date information
- Show respect for our staff, mentors, other community members and Dardi Munwurro property
- Tell us if you will not be attending an appointment, group or camp
- Not behave in a violent, aggressive or threatening manner when attending a group camp or other activity
- Not be intoxicated or under the influence of drugs while attending our programs

#### TRAINING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Offering a range of Aboriginal family violence training and professional development programs
- Diploma of Community Services, Aboriginal Healing and Family Violence delivered in partnership with RMIT

#### VICTORIAN ABORIGINAL MEN'S GATHERING

- Annual gathering for Victorian and interstate men
- Tackling key issues impacting the Aboriginal community

#### WOMEN'S HEALING JOURNEY PROGRAM

- Providing support to women and children related to the men undertaking Dardi Munwurro programs
- Connecting women with access to services they require

#### ABORIGINAL MEN'S HEALING AND BEHAVIOUR CHANGE PROGRAM

- Challenging men to take responsibility and be accountable for their actions
- Working towards building a strong spirit and culture
- Building healthy relationships

#### ALCOHOL & OTHER DRUGS (AOD) SERVICES

• Group based healing and behaviour change programs in Victorian prisons

#### PRISONS PROGRAM

- Working with all First Nations people seeking support for an AOD issue
- Working with referral services and directly with the community

#### NGARRA JARRANOUNITH PLACE

- Residential healing and behaviour change program
- Men live independently in a provided residential property for up to 16 weeks
- Transitional support provided for up to 18 months

#### YOUTH SERVICES

- Offering a vast range of programs for Aboriginal young men and women aged between 10-25yo.
- Bramung Jaarn program for Aboriginal young men aged between 10-25yo.
- Case management, mentoring support.
- Youth hub for young men and women

#### CHANGING WAYS PROGRAM

• Changing Ways Program works directly with 18 & over persons using family violence and all family and children experiencing family violence, to increase safety and to provide tailored healing and emotional health support.

#### FAMILY CENTRED APPROACH PROGRAM (DANDENONG)

- Providing families support to heal from intergenerational trauma
- Case management
- Home support & parenting support

#### EMPLOYMENT PATHWAYS PROGRAM

• Supporting mob through their employment pathways journey
